

Welcome to Stockholm!

Sights to explore

- 1 Vasagatan/Central Station.** Trains connecting Stockholm with Arlanda Airport and other cities. Close to Drottninggatan shopping district.
- 2 Ice Bar/Casino Cosmopol.** Experience Stockholm's coolest bar! The temperature is -5 °C all year round. Close to Stockholm's international casino – Casino Cosmopol.
- 3 Hötorget.** Stockholm's central fruit and vegetable market. Stockholm Concert Hall, where the Nobel Prize ceremony takes place, is also located here. Excellent shopping, restaurant and cinema facilities.
- 4 Stureplan.** Shopping, restaurants and nightlife!
- 5 Vasa Museum/Nordiska museet.** Vasa Museum with the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. Other museums in the area; Nordiska museet and Junibacken. [Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!](#)
- 6 ABBA The Museum/ Gröna Lund.** Stockholm's amusement park for grown-ups and kids. It's also home to the Liljevalchs (art and design) and the ABBA Museum, which is set to open in May 2013. [Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!](#)
- 7 Skansen.** Stockholm's open air museum with both country side houses and town quarters gathered from all Sweden from the mid-19th century. Also a zoo with both Swedish and foreign animals. Do not miss the tropical aquarium.
- 8 Historiska Museet/Djurgårdsbron.** Djurgården's Visitor's Centre is located here, providing info on all of the museums, attractions and activities on Djurgården. A short walk to The Swedish History Museum, the museum of Vikings and the beautiful Gold Room.
- 9 Strandvägen/Nybrokajen.** Shopping district with exclusive restaurants. Departure point for excursions and dining cruises in the archipelago. [Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!](#)
- 10 Gallerian/Regeringsgatan.** City centre – for those of you who love shopping!
- 11 Strömgatan.** Close to the open garden of Kungsträdgården and Strömkajen for boat sightseeing tours of the city.
- 12 Kornhamnstorg.** Old town is Stockholm's original heart. A cluster of shops, restaurants and a perfect place to feel the historical vibe of the city.
- 13 Skeppsbron.** A good starting point to explore the city's old town, the original heart of Stockholm. Here you'll find several souvenir shops. [Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!](#)
- 14 Royal Palace.** Royal Palace is a combination of royal residence and royal working place and cultural and historical monuments open for visitors. [Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!](#)
- 15 City Hall.** Home of the Nobel Prize dinner, this beautiful building attracts around 400 000 visitors and holds the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm.
- C Skeppsholmen.** Once a military island now houses modern art at Moderna Museet, the Museum of Far Eastern Antiquities and the Swedish Museum of Architecture.
- E Cruise Berth/Viking Line.** This is where many cruise ships visiting Stockholm are docked and also where the cruise ships to Finland depart.
- F Fotografiska.** At Fotografiska you can visit exhibitions by famous photographers and their shop, dedicated to the medium of photography.
