- Vasagatar/Central Station. Trains connecting Stockholm with Arlanda Airport and other cities. Close to Drottninggatan shopping district.
- Ice Bar/Casino Cosmopol. Experience Stockholm's coolest bar!
 The temperature is -5 °C all year round. Close to Stockholm's international casino Casino Cosmopol.
- Hötorget. Stockholm's central fruit and vegetable market. Stockholm Concert Hall, where the Nobel Prize ceremony takes place, is also located here. Excellent shopping, restaurant and cinema facilities.
- Stureplan. Shopping, restaurants and nightlife!
- Vasa Museum/Nordiska museet. Vasa Museum with the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. Other museums in the area; Nordiska museet and Junibacken. Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!
- ABBA The Museum/ Gröna Lund. Stockholm's amusement park for grown-ups and kids. It's also home to the Liljevalchs (art and design) and the ABBA Museum, which is set to open in May 2013. Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!
- Skansen. Stockholm's open air museum with both country side houses and town quarters gathered from all Sweden from the mid-19th century. Also a zoo with both Swedish and foreign animals. Do not miss the tropical aquarium.
- Historiska Museet/Djurgårdsbron. Djurgården's Visitor's Centre is located here, providing info on all of the museums, attractions and activities on Djurgården. A short walk to The Swedish History Museum, the museum of Vikings and the beautiful Gold Room.
- Strandvägen/Nybrokajen. Shopping district with exclusive restaurants. Departure point for excursions and dining cruises in the archipelago. Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!
- Gallerian/Regeringsgatan. City centre for those of you who love shopping!
- Strömgatan, Close to the open garden of Kungsträdgården and Strömkaien for boat sightseeing tours of the city.
- Kornhamnstorg. Old town is Stockholm's original heart. A cluster of shops, restaurants and a perfect place to feel the historical vibe of the city.
- Skeppsbron. A good starting point to explore the city's old town, the original heart of Stockholm. Here you'll find several souvenir shops, Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!
- Royal Palace. Royal Palace is a combination of royal residence and royal working place and cultural and historical monuments open for visitors. Change to Hop-On Hop-Off boat!
 - City Hall. Home of the Nobel Prize dinner, this beautiful building attracts around 400 000 visitors and holds the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm.

 - Fotografiska. At Fotografiska you can visit exhibitions by famous photographers and their shop, dedicated to the medium of photography.
